3. Inspected the identity documents of the owners/beneficiaries to establish whether or not the "black owners" meet the requirements for recognition, namely Black, Coloured, Indian and Chinese born in South Africa or naturalised before 1994, and whether male or female.
4. Determined the percentage interest held by such black persons or black women in the business.
